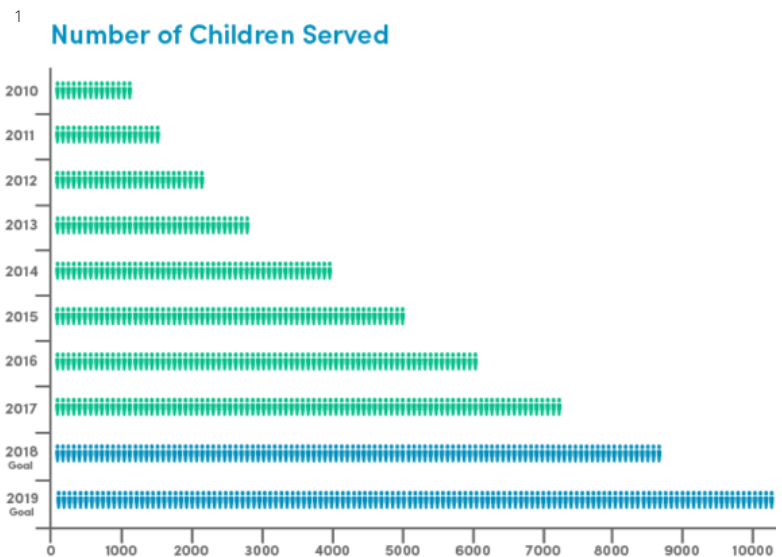




BACKGROUND

Founded at Stanford University in 2000, Kesem has been a beacon of hope for families impacted by cancer. Kesem is a nationwide non-profit organization that is driven by dedicated college students who are determined to make a difference in the lives of children through and after their parent's cancer. Our primary program, Camp Kesem, offers free summer camp to children who have been affected by parents with cancer.



Our Mission

Over 5 million children are affected by a parent's cancer, our mission is to ensure that those children are never alone. We are committed to providing a safe and loving space for children impacted by a parent's cancer. At Camp Kesem, we are dedicated to helping children not only through and beyond their parent's cancer. We aim to provide a foundation for these children that helps them to build confidence, improve communication skills and enhance their attitude and outlook on life.

Our Counselors

At Camp Kesem, our counselors and staff are composed of highly trained and dedicated volunteer college students. These student leaders are carefully chosen through a competitive interview process and are provided with thorough and extensive training before camp. About 80% of our counselors have been impacted by a family member with cancer, so they can better understand and help our campers.



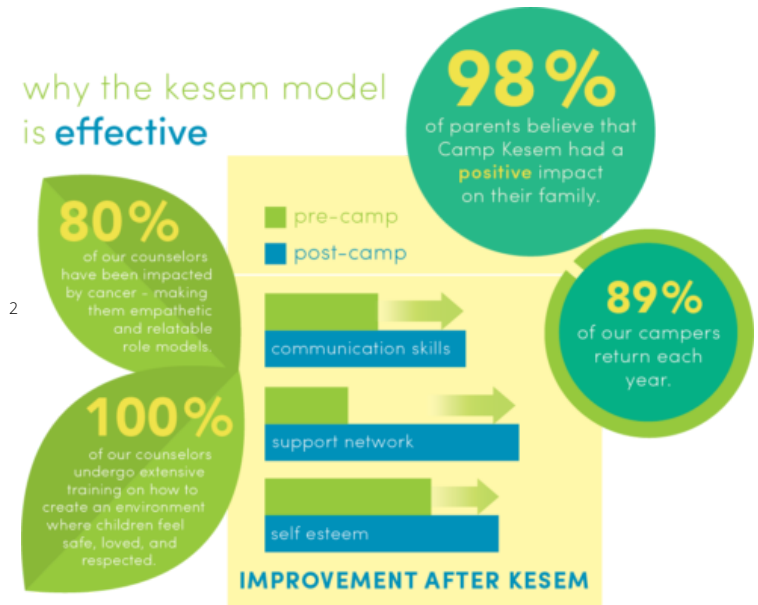
Camp Kesem at Long Beach State
